The registration fee includes:

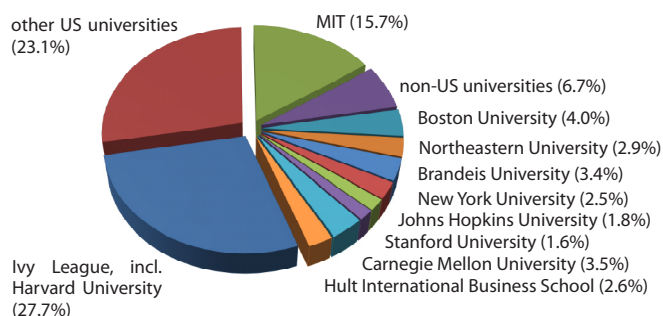
- Online access to the resume database prior to the Fair and convenient online interview scheduling.

Candidate and employer profiles

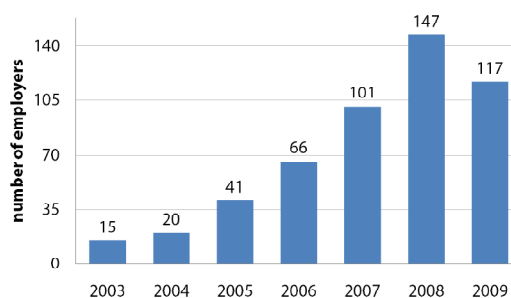
