### What is the Specialization Year?

It is the 2nd year of the Master's program.

### Who is eligible for admission?

- Students with a bachelor in computer science or related subject.

Necessary credit hours : 160 (=240 ECTS points).

- Students with a bachelor plus additional credit hours of a graduate program (e.g. 1st year of a Master's program).

Necessary credit hours: 160 (=240 ECTS points).

- Students who are fluent in English.

### What is special?

- Study plans drawn up to meet the needs of each individual student, designed for becoming an expert in the specialization topic chosen.

- Individual academic advisor for each student for the entire year.

- Various unique courses for development of creative, intellectual, communicational and social skills.
